**ST. CATHARINES, ONTARIO HOSTS 28TH NATIONAL YOUTH
CHAMPIONSHIPS**

The 28th Canadian National Youth Championships will take place at Parkway Lanes, St. Catharines, Ontario May 27 – 30.

.Bowlers from BC, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Northern Ontario, Southern Ontario, Quebec and New Brunswick will compete.

Each province has a girls and boys team made up of four players of different age categories Bantam (11 and under), Junior (12-14), Intermediate (15, 16, 17) and Seniors (18 and not 22). All ages are determined as of August 1st of 2009. Provincial qualifying tournaments determined the competitors of each team. More than 150 bowlers, family members and guests from across Canada are expected to travel to St. Catharines for the tournament.

The competition will consist of boy's and girl's singles, mixed doubles, girls and boys team. They will play round robin matches against players in their age division i.e. bantam girls against bantam girls. Each match won will be awarded one point and a half point for ties. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in each event and ties for medals will be broken by a complete game bowled. Subsequent ties will be broken in the same manner. This makes for many exciting tie-breakers! All Events medals will also be awarded in each age division (girls and boys) for the highest accumulated pinfall.

Southern Ontario has the highest medal count over the 27 year history of the championships with 344 followed by Quebec and British Columbia with 209 and 291.
